National Board of Directors

What is the Board of Directors?

The Board of Directors is a group of medical students and non-medical students responsible for overseeing the financial, legal, and long-term strategic plans for MSFC. The Board hires, supervises, and works closely with the Executive Director of MSFC. Ultimately, the Board bears final legal responsibility for the health and welfare of MSFC.

How is the Board different from the SAC?

The Board focuses on policy and organizational planning on a big-picture, long-term basis. Unlike the SAC, the Board does not work with individual MSFC chapters or regions to plan events or regional programs.

Who can apply?

Anyone. Medical students who have been active in MSFC at their schools are encouraged to apply. Non-medical students who have an interest in MSFC's mission are also encouraged. The Board is especially interested in receiving applications from men, current abortion providers, students living in anti-choice regions, and people of diverse backgrounds.
